


# Dumbarton Walks Map

This map shows eight popular walks around Dumbarton. All walks are on waymarked paths and are suitable for casual walkers, although stout footwear and warm & waterproof clothing are advisable.

Each walk is clearly shown on a specially prepared map. Red arrows indicate the suggested direction of the walk, and the map scale has been adjusted for each walk.

## Key to map symbols:

*Note: The route taken by each walk is shown in red and is marked in miles from the start point.*

-  Minor road
-  Vehicle track
-  Path, indistinct path
-  Railway line, railway station
-  Built up area, building, ruin
-  Wall or fence

*Note: For clarity walls and fences have only been shown where they are helpful to navigation.*

-  Loch, marshy ground, pond
-  Large river, stream, bridge
-  Woodland or forest
