I declare that the result of the election in the Ward 3 - Dumbarton is as follows.

There are 4 councillor(s) to be elected.

The percentage poll was 51.2%. There were 6,562 valid ballot papers and 168 rejected ballot papers.

The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected is 1,313.

The first preference votes received by each of the candidates and the stage at which any candidate was elected is as follows:
