All of the above were happy and pleased to be co-opted as community councillors for DHCC.

The ongoing issue of the bus services to and from Duntocher on a Sunday was discussed. John has written to various bus companies but none seem willing, or able, at the moment to amend their timetables to provide a better Sunday service.

The possibility of a Community Minibus, run in conjunction with Faifley CC, was suggested. This will need further discussion and an approach made to Faifley CC to see if this would be possible.

The lack of X-ray facilities at the new Clydebank Health Centre was mentioned. It was decided that a combined approach with other CC's in the Clydebank area might be the best way to deal with this, and

the issue of bus services to and from the new health centre, college and sports centre. Present services run no closer than the bus terminus in Clydebank, leaving a considerable walk to the new facilities.

The possibility of using the Antonine Sports Centre (ACS) for meetings and office space was raised. It was suggested that Tom and Jackie meet with the ACS to discuss the possibility and feed back at the next meeting.
