Headline Figures

Applications	266	268	230	273	243	258

- Slight decrease in applications and assessments
- Repeat homelessness has reduced - 9 repeat applications in Q1 2019/20 compared to 15 in Q1 2018/19



Assessments

	2018/19	2019/20 Q1	2019/20 Q2
Decision within 28 days	99%	100%	98%
Households losing contact	10.8%	13%	7%
Cases closed as housed	62%	56%	62%

- **82% assessed as unintentionally homeless**
- **4% assessed as intentionally homeless**
- **Reducing number of households losing contact assumed within our RRTP**

Who is presenting?

- 27% were aged between 16 and 24
- 67% were single people
- 19% were single parents
- 26% households had children in them



Why do people find themselves homeless?

- 27% asked to leave
- 12% relationship breakdown, non violent
- 18% dispute within household: violent or abusive
- 12% other action by landlord



Temporary accommodation

	2018/19	2019/20 Q1	2019/20 Q2
% of household requiring temporary accommodation that received an offer	100%	100%	100%
Breaches of Unsuitable Accommodation Order	0	0	0

- Everyone who required emergency or temporary accommodation was offered it
- Low levels of refusals of temporary accommodation

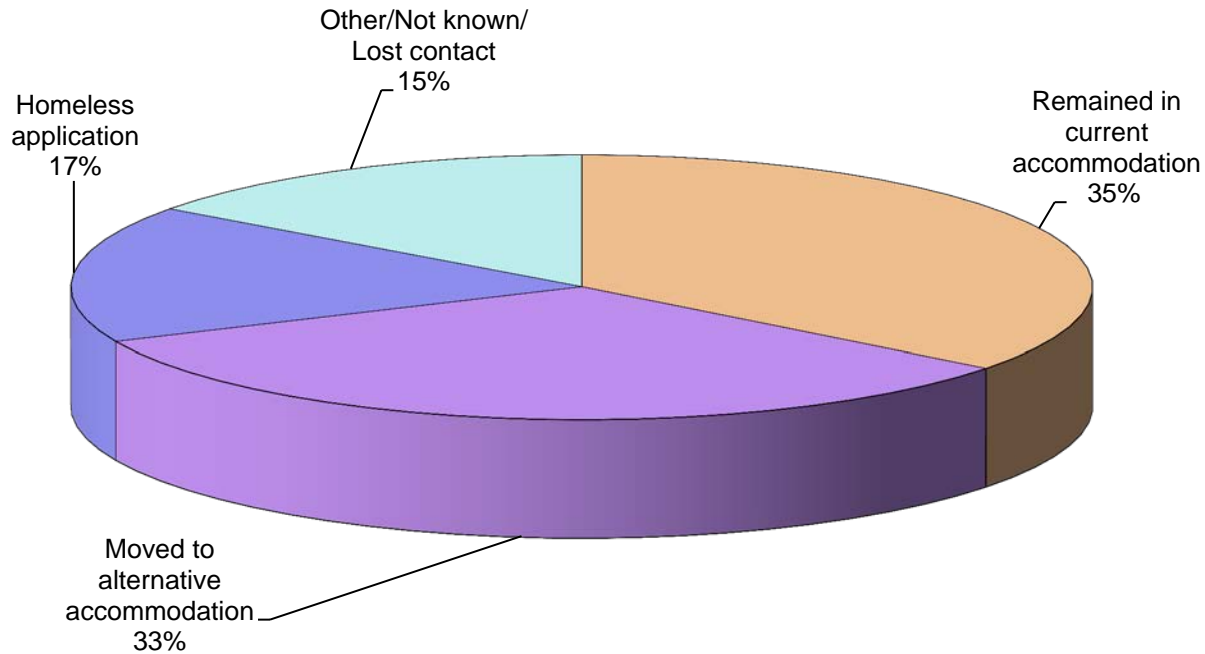


Outcomes for homeless households

	2018/19	2019/20 Q1	2019/20 Q2
Cases closed as housed	62%	56%	62%
% of WDC lets to homeless households	41%	39%	39%
% of RSL lets to homeless households	34%	36%	n/a
% of all lets to homeless households	39%	38%	n/a
