

1 Strathleven House

4 miles (return) / 1½ - 2 hours



Strathleven House is a grade 'A' listed building. It was built in 1700 in the Palladian style and inhabited until the middle of the twentieth century. The mansion then lay derelict for over forty years until its restoration and subsequent use as a business centre.

B Although only a few miles long, the River Leven is one of the fastest-flowing rivers in Scotland, and is tidal as far as Dalquhurn Point.
