

# 4 The Crags Circular Path

8 miles / 3 - 4 hours

**B**

Overtoun House dates from 1862 and is an example of the Scots Baronial architectural style typical of the high Victorian period.

**A**

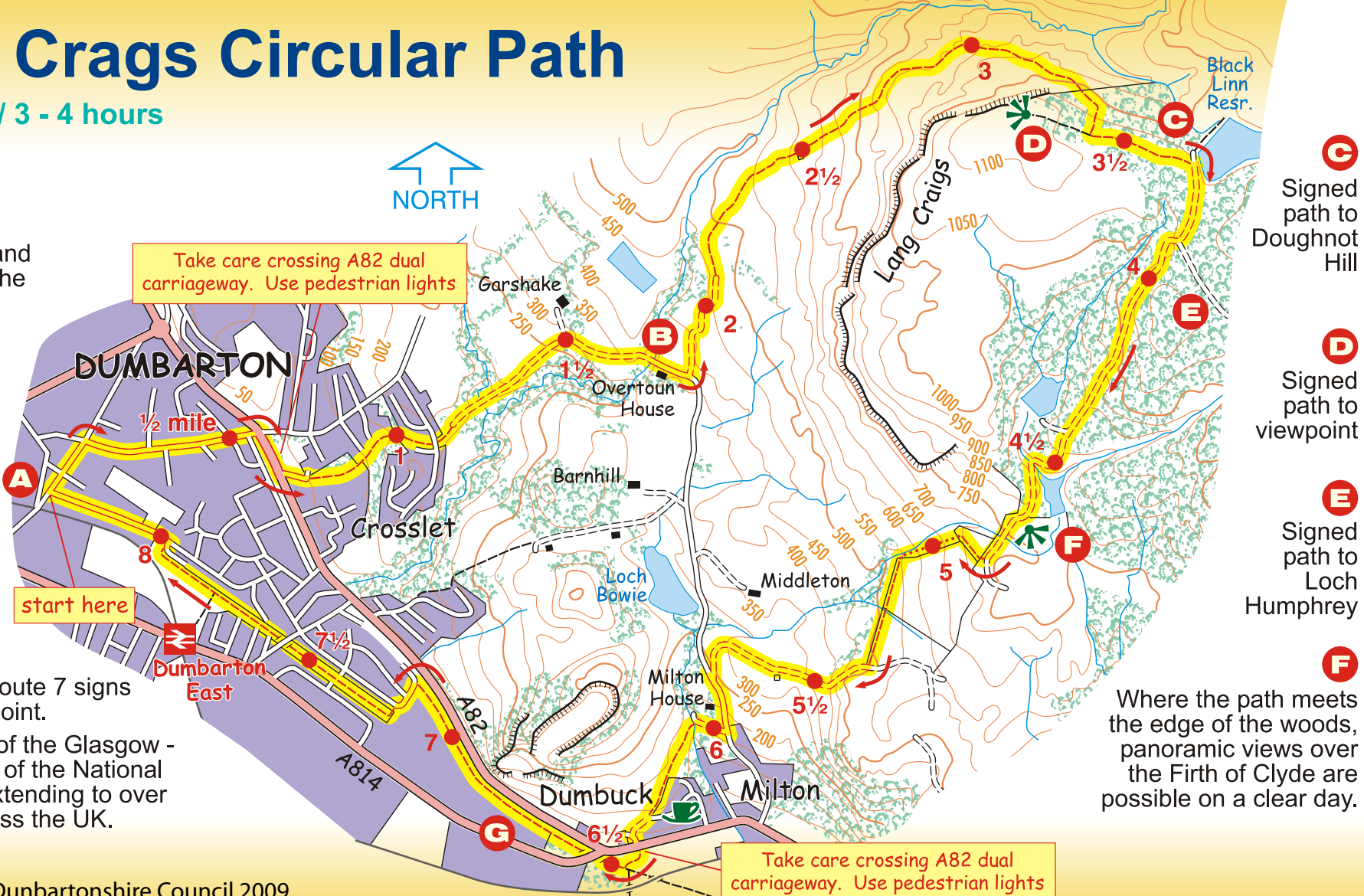
Start from the junction of Crosslet Road and Bonhill Road.

**G**

Follow National Route 7 signs back to the start point.

This route is part of the Glasgow - Inverness section of the National Cycle Network, extending to over 12,000 miles across the UK.

Take care crossing A82 dual carriageway. Use pedestrian lights



**C**

Signed path to Doughnot Hill

**D**

Signed path to viewpoint

**E**

Signed path to Loch Humphrey

Where the path meets the edge of the woods, panoramic views over the Firth of Clyde are possible on a clear day.

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
